There are several locations to get a view of a class or race.

– The front deck is a popular area where the awning can be rolled out and chairs be brought out from inside.

– The area near the flag pole, adjacent to the deck also provides a good elevated view of the sailing on pleasant bay. There are umbrellas in the club house for this area.

– The end of the dock is also a good place but although closer, you are not as elevated. All these locations are better with binoculars if you have them.

– Patrol or other spectator boats often have additional space to take a person or two. This is the best way to view the sailors if you have this opportunity.
