Beach / Club Boat storage If you store you own sunfish, laser, or 420 at the club please label **all** of the parts and the hull.

Big changes to Pleasant Bay for 2010: (An excerpt from the Arey's Pond Boat Yard News Brief)

- Tides are higher and lower than last year.
- Tides are 40 minutes earlier than posted on the official 2010 tide charts.
- The currents, due to the new opening, are faster than last year.
- Sand is building up throughout the Bay, especially in Little Pleasant Bay which is much shallower this year in the center down to the new break and by Mayflower Point and the Arey's Pond Sailing School moorings.
- This means that in 2009 sailors had about a four hour window to set sail from Little Pleasant Bay to Chatham Light with a NW wind down and a SW wind back. Due to the increasing sand shoal activity through the new cut, that window on the back side for sailing is now reduced in 2010 to about two hours, an hour before high tide and an hour after high tide.

Windsurfing Corner:

Come on out for windsurfing. It's fun, exciting, a great workout and easy to learn. Classes are Wednesdays and Friday mornings for all levels and ages. Note that the East Coast Junior Windsurfing Championship (held at CYC last year) is August 3-5 at Vineyard Haven Yacht Club, for Silver and Gold fleets.

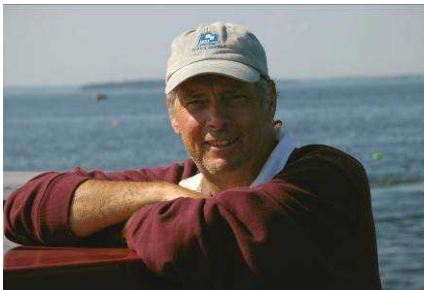
